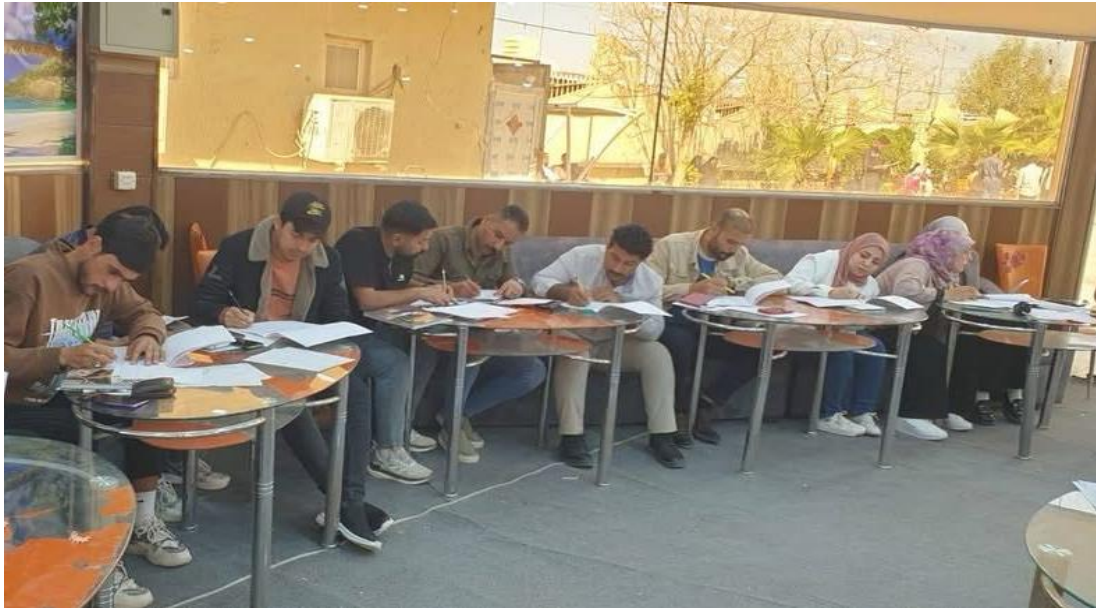


Al-Qasim Green University Elects Student Representative to Join University Council
